## Sick Pay Entitlement

You will be entitled to receive sick pay for the following periods:

| Length of continuous service | Amount of sick pay |
| :---: | :---: |
| During $1^{\text {st }}$ year of service | 1 months' full pay \& (after completing 4 <br> months' service) 2 months' half pay |
| During $2^{\text {nd }}$ year of service | 2 months' full pay \& 2 months' half pay |
| During $3^{\text {rd }}$ year of service | 4 months' full pay \& 4months' half pay |
| During $4^{\text {th }}$ and $5^{\text {th }}$ years of service | 5 months' full pay \& 5 months' half pay |
| After 5 years service | 6 months' full pay \& 6 months' half pay |

Please note: that Saturdays count towards your sickness allowance if any absence extends over a weekend. That in a situation where an employee is receiving half sick pay, 'half rate' will also apply to any car allowance payments.
