

Garden Waste

Garden waste is put into the green bin at home.



2
The collection crew empty the green wheeled bin on a fortnightly basis.



3
The garden waste is emptied and stored at Cupid Green Depot.



4
It is then transported to a windrow facility in Middlesex, where it is shredded and put into windrows to compost in a natural way. It is regularly rotated and takes an average of 16 weeks to turn into compost.



5
The compost is used on farmland to grow crops.



6
Food grown using the compost is sold in shops for all to buy.
