



Southernwood Close

Supported Housing Scheme

Supported housing is accommodation for people who are aged 60 and over, who can live on their own but who would like to have support close by.

We have 33 supported housing schemes across Dacorum with a range of self-contained flats and bungalows. Social gatherings and activities are often available within these schemes.

Southernwood Close in Adeyfield, Hemel Hempstead, is a purpose-built supported scheme.

Where is Southernwood Close?

Southernwood Close is located in a residential area, just off Adeyfield Road in Hemel Hempstead, close to local shops at Queen's Square and near to bus stops.

The nearest doctors' surgery is Everest House Surgery, which is about a five-minute walk away.

How many flats are there?

There are 36 self-contained flats and bungalows in the scheme.

What facilities are there?

There is a recently decorated communal lounge with new, comfortable furniture, a pool table and a dart board. The scheme has beautiful well-kept gardens with a patio and a gazebo. There is also a launderette and a shelter for mobility scooters as well as a car park.

What activities do other tenants participate in?

There are regular coffee mornings every week as well as darts and pool games. Some of the residents plan social events within the scheme such as fish and chip suppers and bingo, and many residents also go on day trips out to the seaside. We also run tablet courses to help tenants get online as well as a range of other **Tenant Academy** courses.
