APPLICATION FOR THE REGISTRATION OF A FOOD BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENT

(Regulation (EC) No. 852/2004 on the Hygiene of Foodstuffs, Article 6(2))

This form should be completed by food business operators in respect of new food business establishments and submitted to the relevant food authority 28 days before commencing food operations. On the basis of the activities carried out, certain food business establishments are required to be <u>approved</u> rather than <u>registered</u>. If you are unsure whether any aspect of your food operations would require your establishment to be approved, please contact [the Food Authority] for guidance.

NOTES ON REGISTRATION OF FOOD PREMISES

Who needs to register?

Any food undertaking or business which involves a degree of organisation and continuity of activity must be registered with the Council. The definition of Food Business includes activities carried on for profit or not, whether public or private, and which involve the production, processing, and distribution of food.

Who doesn't need to register?

Certain activities may be exempt from registration including:

- Primary production for private domestic use
- Preparation, handling or storage of food for private domestic use
- Direct sale by the producer of small quantities of primary products to the final consumer, or to local retailers supplying the final consumer
- Occasional preparation by individuals or groups for gatherings
- Occasional preparation by individuals or groups for sale at charitable events
- Childminders (OFSTED share registration details with the local authority)

IF YOU DON'T NEED TO REGISTER BUT SUPPLY FOOD TO OTHERS, the food must be safe to eat.

Which person has to register?

The 'Food Business Operator' is responsible for registering the food business or activity. This is the person legally or naturally responsible for ensuring the requirements of food law are met by the business or activity under their control. As a general guide the person in charge should make sure that the business or activity is registered or exempt.

When do I have to register?

You must complete and return this form at least 28 days before the business or food activities are to start. Failing to do this is an offence for which the Food Business Operator can be prosecuted. If you wish to start your business or activity before 28 days have passed you should contact the Council at the address given overleaf FIRST!

Do I get a registration certificate?

Registration certificates are not issued because they could cause confusion for the public and imply that food laws are being met. Registering your business allows the Council to decide when it will inspect your food activities, and who it needs to send to do this.

Do I need to register every year?

Registration is only required once for each business or activity provided nothing substantial changes. You must tell the Council of any substantial changes to your business. They will then advise you if re-registration is required.

You must also notify them of a change of operator, if the nature of the business changes, or if there is a change of the address at which moveable premises are kept. The new operator will, have to complete an application form. If the local authority wishes to change the entry in the Register because of information which it receives from someone else you will be given 28 days notice and an opportunity to comment on the proposed change

What happens to the information I supply?

The details will be entered on to a register kept by the Council. Only information on the address and type of food business/ activity you operate will be available to the general public. You will be allowed access to your own information on the register if you want to check that it is accurate.
