

Bovingdon Neighbourhood Area Plan Referendum Information Statement

A referendum relating to the adoption of the Bovingdon Neighbourhood Area Plan will be held on Thursday 13 June 2024.

The question which will be asked in the referendum is:

“Do you want Dacorum Borough Council to use the neighbourhood plan for Bovingdon Parish to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?”

The referendum area is identified on the map which is included with this information statement.

The referendum area is identical to the area which has been designated as the Bovingdon Neighbourhood Area.

A person is entitled to vote in the referendum if on Thursday 13 June 2024:

- He or she is entitled to vote in a local government election in the referendum area; and
- His or her qualifying address for the election is in the referendum area. A person’s qualifying address is, in relation to a person registered in the register of electors, the address in respect of which he or she is entitled to be registered.

The referendum expenses limit that will apply in relation to the referendum is £2,575.58. The number of persons entitled to vote in the referendum by which that limit has been calculated is 3,620.

The referendum will be conducted in accordance with procedures which are similar to those used at local government elections.
